## GUIDANCE for FEE PAYMENT by INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS,

- 1. In the fee structure, ERD means EARNING RATE DISCOUNT
- 2. EARNING means income from profession only through salary or profit/income from business
- 3. If you are professionally active and engaged in employment or enterprise/business and your annual EARNINGS are up to GBP 3500, the valid annual fee is GBP 47 (ERD 1)
- 4. If your status as described above fetches annual earnings are above GBP 3500 to GBP 7000, the valid fee is GBP 68 (ERD 2)
- 5. IF your annual earnings exceed GBP 7000, the valid fee is GBP 122
- 6. If you are retired and fully disengaged from employment or business resulting in no earnings from profession, the valid fee is GBP 47
- 7. If you are retired, but still deriving earnings from profession, stipulations in ERD 1 as in St No 4 or ERD 2 as in St No 5 are applicable.
- 8. If you are retired from full time engagement, but your part time engagement in profession derives annual earnings exceeding GBP 7000, the valid fee is GBP 72
- 9. If you are a graduate member, the valid fee is GBP 72 (see definition of GRADUATE MEMBER in website)
- 10. If you are member of other associations named by TI in it's website, the valid fee is GBP 87
