### Background of conference

India's textile sector, a cornerstone of the economy, meets significant domestic fabric demands and plays a pivotal role in job creation and export revenue. Amidst its economic contributions, the sector faces growing environmental concerns, emphasizing the urgency for sustainable practices. In the face of climate change and resource depletion, embracing circular economy principles—focusing on resource conservation, waste reduction, and exploring end-of-life alternatives—becomes imperative.

The Circle Back campaign, launched by the Ministry of Textiles, Government of India aims to reshape consumer behavior towards a more circular and responsible textile industry. This campaign especially seeks to leverage the influential power of youth, empowering them as future leaders to steer the sector towards sustainability.

To further this goal, a one-day conference is being organized by North India Section of the Textile Institute Manchester (NISTI) in collaboration with IIT on 14th December, 2024 at IIT Delhi. This Conference aims creating a dynamic forum for discussing this pressing issue at various levels— within the industry, through the lens of entrepreneurship, and across the entire supply chain. This event will gather students, policy makers, industry experts, and academicians to not only discuss jobs, market trends, and opportunities but also to foster a space for innovation and collaborative problem-solving.

### Objective

The Conference primarily aims at raising awareness, inspire action, and forge collaborative pathways towards a more sustainable textile and clothing industry. By engaging IIT and its students, we aspire to cultivate a community of informed advocates and innovators, equipped to contribute to the industry's transformation in line with global sustainability goals.

## Sessions Overview

**Inaugural Session:** Senior government functionaries and industry leaders shall delve upon the initiatives undertaken by the government and industry to ensure circularity and sustainability in production and consumption of textile and apparel products

**Technical Session-1:** Veterans from industry and academia and research shall discuss and present before the audience, the innovations, research and initiatives on fibers and fabrics to enhance sustainability in textile manufacturing.

**Poster Competition:** The session on poster presentation shall open up young minds on the new ideas to attain sustainability in production and consumption of textiles and clothing.

**Technical Session-2&3:** Leading textile professionals shall dive into the ways and means to ensure sustainability while dyeing, processing and finishing of textiles. Sustainability in fast fashion through responsive production and use of clothing, post-consumer waste handling shall be dealt with by the clothing and fashion professionals from the manufacturing, design, leading buying houses and consumer activists will be discussed during these sessions.

**Panel Discussion:** Learned professionals shall sit together on one platform and delve into the theme area of the seminar and arrive at the concluding essence of initiatives to be undertaken in the area of " Sustainability and Circularity in Textiles and Clothing - How to make it happen".

**Valedictory Session:** Dignitaries from government and industry shall draw the conclusion of whole day proceedings and shall discuss on the roadmap for the industry for implementation of recommendations of experts. Awards to the winners of poster competition shall be presented during this session.
